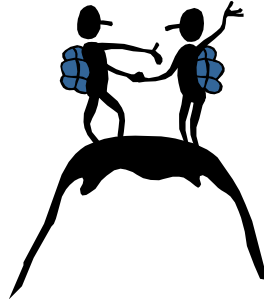

Accommodation

Warrumbungle Mountain Motel (on 25 acres)

10kms from Coonabarabran, 20kms from the National Park

Large rooms which include 1 queen bed, 1 single bed and 2 double bunks, table and chairs, TV, heating/cooling, all linen, ensuite bathroom and kitchenette with all cooking facilities – fully self-contained.

There is a marquee where we can meet for Happy Hour.

There is a swimming pool and a guest laundry.

This is the accommodation the Club used for the Warrumbungle trip in 2003.

Cost 2 per room = \$325 per person for 7 nights

3 per room = \$241 per person for 7 nights

4 per room = \$220 per person for 7 nights

There may be powered sites available for 3 or 4 caravans/campervans as well (not confirmed yet).
